Visa: participants from GCC are required to have their valid National ID, and a valid passport for non GCC counties. For some countries visas are obtainable on arrival at the airport. Currency: Omani Rial (OMR) is the national currency (~0.386 USD). Major credit cards are accepted in all hotels, restaurants and shopping malls. Exchange offices and ATM machines are readily available.

Climate: During November, the Muscat region typically enjoys dry and clear weather conditions, with temperatures between 20 and 30°C.
