Participation of the Secretary-General of the Association of Arab Universities in the Opening of the International Higher Education Forum "EdUGate"







His Excellency Prof. Amr Ezzat Salama, Secretary-General of the Association of Arab Universities, took part in the opening ceremony of the 17th edition of the International Forum and Exhibition for Higher Education and Training (EdUGate 2025), held on Sunday, August 3, 2025, at the Royal Kempinski Hotel in New Cairo. The event was held under the patronage of H.E. Prof. Ayman Ashour, Minister of Higher Education and Scientific Research of the Arab Republic of Egypt, and carried the theme: "The Future of Education Begins in Egypt."

EdUGate stands as one of the region's most prominent platforms for academic exchange, bringing together universities and educational institutions from across the globe. This year's edition welcomed over 100 universities and institutions from Egypt, the Arab world, Europe, Asia, and Africa, with Malaysia's university delegation honored as the guest of distinction.

Prof. Salama's participation reflects the Association's ongoing commitment to supporting initiatives that advance the quality of higher education and foster academic collaboration and knowledge exchange at both regional and international levels.











The Association of Arab Universities Participates in the First Annual Arab Forum on Artificial Intelligence Under the Patronage of the Secretary-General of the League of Arab States







A delegation from the Association of Arab Universities, headed by H.E. Prof. Amr Ezzat Salama, Secretary-General of the Association, took part in the proceedings of the First Annual Arab Forum on Artificial Intelligence, held under the patronage and in the presence of H.E. Mr. Ahmed Aboul Gheit, Secretary-General of the League of Arab States.

The forum was convened in implementation of the resolution adopted at the Arab Economic and Social Development Summit, held in Baghdad in May 2025. It represents a significant step toward activating the Arab Artificial Intelligence Initiative launched by H.E. Mr. Ahmed Aboul Gheit, aimed at fostering development and enhancing competitiveness across Arab countries.

The Association of Arab Universities was represented by Prof. Dr. Amr Ezzat Salama, Secretary-General, and Prof. Dr. Waleed Salama, Advisor to the Association, who participated in the opening alongside several high-level Arab officials, including the Egyptian Minister of Communications and Information Technology, the Yemeni Minister of Transport, the Egyptian Minister of Education and Technical Education, and members of the diplomatic and consular corps in Egypt.

In his opening remarks, the Secretary-General of the League of Arab States described artificial intelligence as a "revolution in ways of thinking and working," emphasizing its

rapid advancements that have turned the global scene into what he called "an arms race" among major powers. He urged Arab countries to double their efforts in research and development and underscored the necessity of increasing investment in this sector to enhance the region's capacity to attract investments.

H.E. Prof. Amr Ezzat Salama highlighted the role of the Association of Arab Universities in this field within Arab higher education institutions, outlining the projects initiated by the Association to promote the application of artificial intelligence in higher education. He also presented the Association's vision for implementing and operationalizing the Arab Artificial Intelligence Initiative launched by the Secretary-General of the League of Arab States.

Speakers unanimously agreed that Arab cooperation in this domain is no longer an option but an "inevitable necessity." A noteworthy announcement was the Egyptian proposal to establish a Council of Arab Ministers for Artificial Intelligence, designed to unify efforts and harmonize policies—reflecting a commitment to building a high-level platform for digital integration.











The Egyptian Minister of Education and Technical Education stated that Egypt has adopted national strategies to integrate artificial intelligence concepts into school curricula starting next academic year, reaffirming that preparing future generations is now a top priority. Prof. Dr. Ismail Abdel Ghaffar, President of the Arab Academy, explained that the idea of the forum stemmed from an ambitious project initiated through the Arab Dialogue on Artificial Intelligence, hosted at the League of Arab States headquarters. This dialogue led to a recommendation in February that laid the foundation for the initiative adopted by the Secretary-General and later endorsed by Arab leaders at the Baghdad Summit in May. Today, the Alamein Forum marks the official launch to transform this vision into tangible reality.

The forum brought together a distinguished group of experts and policymakers to outline a clear roadmap for a unified Arab Artificial Intelligence Strategy and the Arab Charter on AI Ethics, both of which will serve as guiding frameworks for collective action.

AArU Explores Collaboration with LinkedIn to Empower Arab Academia





The Association of Arab Universities (AArU), represented by its Executive Director Prof. Anas Ratib Alsoud, held a fruitful meeting with Mr. Mahdi Rimawi, Director of Academia – MENA at LinkedIn, to explore strategic opportunities for enhancing the academic and professional presence of Arab universities and their faculty members.

The discussions focused on three key priorities previously emphasized by H.E. Prof. Amr Salama, Secretary General of AArU:

Enhancing Academic Cooperation Between the Association of Arab Universities and Bentley University (USA)







On August 3, 2025, Professor Anas Al-Saud, Executive Director of the Association of Arab Universities, welcomed Dr. Razan Haddad, Associate Director of Global & Strategic Initiatives at Bentley University (USA), at the Association's headquarters. The meeting was also attended by Ms. Lina Al-Bitar, Director of General Administration, and Mr. Ziad Amara, Secretary-General office Manager and Head of International Cooperation at the Association.

The discussions focused on strengthening academic cooperation and expanding strategic partnerships in areas such as internationalization, entrepreneurship, digital transformation, and capacity building. Both parties explored opportunities for student and faculty exchanges and the implementation of joint programs aligned with the priorities of higher education in the Arab world.

This visit is part of the Association's ongoing efforts to broaden its international partnerships and enable Arab universities to benefit from leading global practices in education, research, and institutional governance.

At the conclusion of the meeting, Dr. Haddad extended a formal invitation to H.E. Professor

Amr Ezzat Salama, Secretary-General of the Association of Arab Universities, to visit Bentley University in early January 2026. The visit will include the signing of a cooperation agreement and an introduction to the university's pioneering models in academic innovation and leadership. A series of meetings with university officials and affiliated research centers is also planned as part of the visit.





The Association of Arab Universities Holds a Series of Meetings to Develop Regional Institutional Accreditation Standards







The Association of Arab Universities (AArU) held a series of meetings to develop the standards of Regional Institutional Accreditation, under the chairmanship of H.E. Prof. Amr Ezzat Salama, Secretary-General of the Association of Arab Universities. The meetings were attended by Prof. Anas Ratib Soud, Executive Director of AArU; Prof. Hussein Al-Maghreby, Quality and Academic Accreditation Expert; and Mrs. Lina Al-Bitar, Director of the General Administration at AArU. The discussions focused on formulating accreditation standards aligned with international best practices.

Institutional accreditation is considered a strong indicator of an institution's commitment to the quality of the educational process and the achievement of its goals in accordance with internationally recognized standards. It also contributes to strengthening the confidence of society and the labor market in institutional outcomes, supporting graduates' employability, and enhancing university rankings at both the local and international levels.

The Association of Arab Universities Organizes Forum on "Cybersecurity as a Social Responsibility in a Digital World"



Under the patronage of H.E. Prof. Amr Ezzat Salama, Secretary-General of the Association of Arab Universities, Al-Quds Open University organized a scientific forum entitled "Cybersecurity as a Social Responsibility in a Digital World" on Tuesday, August 26, 2025, via Zoom, with wide participation from experts and academics representing various Arab universities.

In his opening remarks, the Secretary-General emphasized that cybersecurity is no longer a purely technical matter, but has become a fundamental pillar of national and economic security. He stressed the pivotal role of universities as the first line of defense in this field.

For his part, Prof. Ibrahim Al-Shaer, President of the University and Chair of the Council for Social Responsibility of Arab Universities, welcomed the participants, noting that hosting this forum reflects the University's belief that cybersecurity is a shared national and societal responsibility. He also called for greater investment in human capital as the cornerstone of digital protection.





Meanwhile, Prof. Youssef Dheeb Awad, Director of the Council for Social Responsibility of Arab Universities and Chair of the opening session, highlighted that the forum embodies Al-Quds Open University's vision of linking academic knowledge with the needs of the digital society, while also contributing to building a shared Arab awareness to confront cybersecurity challenges. The forum concluded with several strategic recommendations, including launching specialized training programs, supporting applied research, and establishing national cybersecurity centers—initiatives that would enhance secure digital transformation and foster a responsible Arab society in a rapidly evolving world.

The Association of Arab Universities Concludes Training Program on "Educational Technology and Instructional Design for E-Learning and Blended Courses"







On Sunday, August 31, 2025, the Association of Arab Universities successfully concluded its training program entitled "Educational Technology and Instructional Design for E-Learning and Blended Courses", organized for Iraqi universities.

The program witnessed the participation of 96 attendees from 12 different countries, providing a platform for dialogue and the exchange of expertise on the latest global trends in e-learning and blended education.

The training aimed to enable participants to grasp the fundamental concepts of e-learning and blended learning, understand the scientific principles of instructional design to ensure high-quality learning outcomes, discuss interactive learning strategies, and explore the use of artificial intelligence applications in course development and enhancing the learning experience.

The course was delivered by Dr. Ashraf Nirokh, an expert in educational technology with over two decades of experience in designing and developing modern digital learning environments.

The Association of Arab Universities affirmed that this program is part of its ongoing efforts to strengthen the capacities of Arab universities and advance their academic programs in line with global educational trends and quality standards.

On Monday, 4 August 2025, the Association of Arab Universities (AArU) held a virtual scientific seminar via Zoom under the title "Arab Impact Factor: Criteria for Indexing Arab Journals". This initiative comes as part of the Association's continuous efforts to advance scientific research, enhance the visibility of Arab journals, and strengthen their presence in international academic rankings.

The seminar was opened by Prof. Anas Rateb Al-Saud, Executive Director of the Association, who underscored the importance of developing a credible Arab framework for journal classification as an essential tool to improve research quality and elevate academic publishing standards across the region. Ms. Lina Al-Bitar, Director of the General Administration at the Association, was also in attendance.

The keynote presentation was delivered by Prof. Mahmoud Abdel-Atv. Founder and Director of the Arab Impact Factor Project at Sohag University, Egypt, and Vice President of the African Academy of Sciences in Nairobi, Kenya. He outlined the project's operational framework, classification criteria, calculation methodology, and its role in addressing the challenges facing Arab journals in attaining recognition within global indexing databases.



Vision of the Council:


